Graham Ross has established an exceptional reputation as an orchestral and choral conductor. He is Director of Music at **Clare College, Cambridge**, co-founder and Principal Conductor of The Dmitri Ensemble, and guest conducts around the world. He studied music at Clare College, Cambridge, conducting at the Royal College of Music, and held a conducting scholarship with the London Symphony Chorus.

Ross is a **renowned conductor of oratorio repertoire**, and is passionate about newly-written and unjustly-neglected works. He is a composer in his own right and records exclusively for **Harmonia Mundi**.

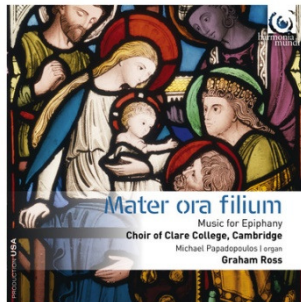

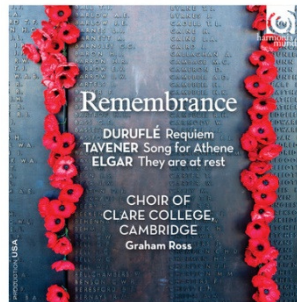

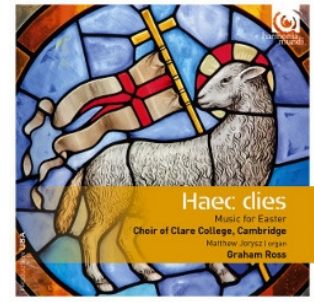
