Over many years of collaboration, the members of the Sacconi Quartet and the London Bridge Trio have formed a distinctive musical friendship. These two remarkable chamber ensembles now present a diverse range of repertoire, featuring outstanding instrumentalists in various combinations from trio to sextet: including English classics from Bridge and Elgar; 'gypsy' influences from Dvorak and Brahms; Viennese favourites from Schoenberg and Beethoven; music from traditional twentieth century Romantics Bridge, Dohnanyi and Korngold, and more.
