Virtuoso violinist Fenella Humphreys presents a reworking of Vivaldi's Four Seasons for an incredible chamber ensemble of violin, accordion, double bass and percussion, bringing a whole new world of diverse and brilliant sounds to Vivaldi's masterpiece.

The four concertos are performed together with three new commissions for the ensemble from **Cheryl Frances-Hoad**, **Adrian Sutton** and **Bethan Morgan-Williams**. The performance lasts one hour; perfect for late nights and festival residencies - or also rush hour, lunchtime or morning performances. Full-length programmes are available with other repertoire on request.

Alongside the concert, the ensemble can offer education and outreach options, from interactive school performances through to composition-based multi-session workshops with a trained workshop leader.
